

Show off your pride for the Connecticut National Guard with this special interest plate sponsored by the National Guard Association of Connecticut (NGACT)



INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING THE NATIONAL GUARD SPECIAL INTEREST LICENSE PLATE FOR BOTH ACTIVE AND RETIRED MEMBERS

1. The vehicle must be currently registered in Connecticut. Any applications received for vehicles registered out-of-state or with a temporary registration will not be accepted. Also, if your registration is due to expire within the next 45 days, you must renew your registration **before** requesting these plates.
2. You may only acquire the same registration type as is currently on your vehicle. For example, if you currently have combination plates on your vehicle, you can only request combination plates - you cannot request combination plates if your vehicle is currently registered with passenger plates.
3. You must be a member of the National Guard Association of Connecticut (NGACT) to purchase this special interest plate. If you are not sure if you are already a member, please contact the NGACT office at: 860-247-5000. 4. Complete the M-37 Special Interest Plate Application (page 2 of these instructions).
5. Return the completed M-37 application to the Special Interest Plate liaison (point of contact below) along with a check for the entire applicable amount. Note: A \$10 processing fee is also required.
 - Example of typical applicable amounts: \$134 for Special Interest Plate, \$10 for processing, \$11 for annual membership dues; total: \$155
 - Make checks payable to NGACT
 - Mail check and applicable documentation (M-37, Membership applications) to: 103 CPTF/CC, 100 Nicholson Road, East Granby, CT 06026-9309, Attn: Major Dave Fecso
6. Once the liaison receives the application(s) and check, they will sign the completed M-37 and send it along with an "NGACT" check to the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) for just the plate registration costs.

1. Select one of the (3) boxes.
2. Complete the existing plate, registration and vehicle information area on the form. Note: Name of Special Interest Organization is NGACTION.
3. If you are choosing block 4, indicate your top 3 choices that you want on your plate.

VANITY PLATE REQUEST(S)

A dot will separate letters from numbers. All letters are equally spaced. No dashes or extra spaces between letters are allowed. *(Example: If plate number ABC123 is ordered, it will appear as ABC•123.)*

List plate request in order of preference. First available preference will be ordered. **THE ORDER CANNOT BE CHANGED.**

Every attempt will be made to accommodate your request, however, the Department of Motor Vehicles reserves the right to deny issuance of certain requests.

VANITY PLATE OPTIONS

- A. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6 letters. Plates manufactured with all letters may include a dot.
 - B. 1 letter followed by 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 numbers.
 - C. 2 letters followed by 1, 2, 3, or 4 numbers.
 - D. 3 letters followed by 1, 2, or 3 numbers.
 - E. 4 letters followed by 1 or 2 numbers.
 - F. 5 letters followed by 1 number.
 - G. 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 numbers followed by 1 letter.
 - H. 1, 2, 3, or 4 numbers followed by 2 letters.
 - I. 1 or 2 numbers followed by 3 or 4 letters.
 - J. 1 number followed by 5 letters.
 - K. Numbers: 00001 through and including 99999.
 - L. Numbers: 000001 through and including 999999.
- Note: Six numbers will be separated by a dot**
(Example: 999•999)

The following organizations may request 5 digits or less ONLY. Pearl Harbor, Fidelco, Marine Corps, Fire Fighter, New England Air Museum.
